ADOPT A VILLAGE

The flagship program 'Adopt a Village' was launched in 2012, through which Canon India aims to create holistic development of the villages across North, East, West, and South India for a period of 5 years.

The program intends to focus on the development of society along with our focus areas including **Education**, **Eye Care**, **Empowerment** and **Environment**, which also forms the basic requirements of a human being.

At present, Canon India has four adopted villages which include Nandrampur Bass in Haryana (North India), Parivali in Maharashtra (West India), Annadodi in Karnataka (South India) and Kalyanpur in Kolkata (East India).



Education

The success of educational initiatives in rural communities is rooted in building strong partnerships with local populations, understanding their unique challenges, and tailoring solutions to meet their specific needs. To create a holistic and supportive learning environment, Canon India has established resource centers, e-learning facilities, and provided Infrastructure improvements to schools across Its Adopted Villages. These initiatives aim to equip children with the resources and opportunities needed to succeed academically and unlock their potential.

Eye Care

As part of Canon India's commitment to community welfare, a key focus of the program is to improve access to essential eye care services. Recognizing the importance of vision health in overall well-being, Canon India has set up Vision Centres in underserved areas to provide critical support. Equipped with a skilled vision technician, these centers offer basic eye care services, including screenings and consultations. For more complex cases, patients are referred by consulting doctors to government hospitals, where they receive free treatment. This initiative aims to address the lack of accessible eye care in rural communities, ensuring that Individuals have the opportunity to receive the care they need for better health and quality of life.



Environment

Contributing to the sustainable future of the community, emphasis is laid on green initiatives encouraging the community members to adapt eco-friendly practices. With environment initiatives, community members are sensitized through cleaning actions, awareness rallies, tree plantation drives, and establishment of kitchen gardens. Solar panels and solar streetlights have been installed in villages ensuring access to electricity. Through these multifaceted endeavors, we strive not only to meet immediate needs but also create a resilient environment for the communities we serve.

Continuing our commitment to Empowerment, a Breast Cancer Screening and Awareness Drive was organized in the Adopted Villages of Nandrampur Bass, Parivali, and Madhya Kalyanpur. The initiative focused on educating women about breast cancer risk factors, symptoms, and early detection, while providing health check-ups and consultations. A total of 257 women were reached, and 2 suspected cases were referred

for further treatment. This drive successfully raised awareness and encouraged **proactive** health management, empowering women

to take charge of their well-being.

In line with our corporate philosophy of Kyosei, Canon India has launched a new CSR initiative - the Skill Development & Livelihood Program. Aligned with our CSR policy's core objective of Empowerment and supporting the Skill India mission, this initiative aims to

bridge the gap between education and employment.
Our goal is to equip youth from underserved
communities with essential employability skills and
sustainable job opportunities, enabling them to thrive
in today's workforce.



Our comprehensive 2.5-month training program covers key areas such as communicative English, IT proficiency, and essential life skills. We welcome youth aged 18-25 with an annual income below ₹3.5 lakhs who are currently not engaged in education or employment.

To begin with, we have established centres in Delhi and Mumbai to serve as skill development hubs. Over the next five years, these centres will train over 2,600 youth, nurturing talent, promoting self-reliance, and enhancing employability. Participants will be prepared for careers in sectors such as BFSI, retail, IT/ITeS, e-commerce, and quick service restaurants.



Tales of Transformation



Arya Prasad: Igniting Curiosity through E-Learning

11-year-old Arya Prasad from Anedoddi Village struggled with academics, showing little interest in learning. Marked as a slow learner, his future seemed uncertain. However, everything changed when he was introduced to an e-learning initiative using educational videos under the Adopt a Village program. This visual approach sparked Arya's curiosity, making complex concepts easier to understand.

Soon, Arya's school attendance improved, and he began actively participating in class. His academic performance soared, earning praise from teachers. The initiative transformed Arya from a disengaged student to an eager learner, demonstrating the power of innovative education in unlocking potential.

Afrin Sheikh: A New Vision for the Future

Afrin Sheikh, a Class III student from Sahapara, Baruipur, faced severe vision problems, including a squint, which hindered her ability to learn and engage in daily activities. Her father, Ajgar Sheikh, a tea stall owner, struggled to afford private medical care, leaving Afrin's condition untreated.

Everything changed when Afrin attended an eye camp organized under the Adopt a Village program, where an ophthalmologist identified her vision issues. Following the camp, Afrin received therapeutic support and a free pair of spectacles from the Vision Center. For the first time, Afrin could see clearly, boosting her confidence and enthusiasm for school.

Thanks to this intervention, Afrin's family saw a significant improvement in her well-being. The spectacles and care allowed Afrin to actively participate in her education and daily life. Her story highlights the transformative impact of accessible healthcare, offering a brighter future for Afrin and many others in underserved communities.



Sanjana's Journey to Empowerment

Sanjana, an 18-year-old from a struggling household, faced life's challenges after her father passed away, leaving her family financially strained. With her brother earning ₹10,000 a month, Sanjana knew she needed a way to help her family.

Her life changed when her friend introduced her to the Skill Development & Livelihood Program. Through the program, Sanjana gained essential skills in communication, problem-solving, and career guidance, which helped her secure a job at Home Centre with a salary of ₹14,000 per month - almost doubling her family's income.

This opportunity transformed her family's life, allowing them to afford better food, healthcare, and education. More importantly, it boosted Sanjana's confidence and inspired her siblings. As she puts it, "Skill Development & Livelihood Program helped me discover my potential. I'm now able to support my family and build a brighter future."

Sanjana's story is a powerful reminder of how the right guidance can empower young people to overcome obstacles and shape a brighter future. ■

Sumit's Path to a Brighter Future

Sumit, the eldest son of a vegetable vendor, grew up in a financially struggling household. With a younger brother requiring ongoing medical care, Sumit was determined to improve his family's circumstances.

Joining the Skill Development & Livelihood Program, Sumit gained vital skills in communication, professionalism, and digital literacy. These skills opened new career opportunities, and his dedication led to securing a Tele Caller role at S&P Global, with a salary of ₹12,500 per month - nearly double his family's previous income.

The job not only eased the family's financial strain but also allowed Sumit to support his brother's medical treatment. His success is a powerful example of how skill development can create lasting change, empowering individuals to overcome challenges and make a positive impact on their lives and families.






Experiential Learning: **Cultivating Scientific Minds**



This initiative empowered the children with crucial health knowledge, contributing to their well-being and fostering a healthier community.






Empowering Lives at Juvenile Home through Photography
